# You're invited to a Public Information Session: Mill Creek End of Pipe Treatment Project

## **Project Overview**

The City of Edmonton will be installing oil and grit separators at two locations near the Mill Creek Ravine in efforts to improve stormwater quality. These will remove sediment and other pollutants from the stormwater before it discharges into Mill Creek and the North Saskatchewan River.

The oil and grit separator units will be installed on 96 Street south of 80 Avenue (Location 1) and west of the intersection of 89 Street and 73 Avenue (Location 2). See maps on reverse for more details.

The session will include displays showing the project background, locations and expected impacts during construction. Project representatives will be on hand to address any questions you may have on the project.

#### Construction and Schedule

The construction of this project involves excavating around the existing storm sewer, installing the oil and grit separator units and backfilling. The contractor's laydown area for equipment and materials will remain inside the construction site indicated on the map. All disturbed areas, such as grassed areas, roads and sidewalks, will be restored to their initial condition at the completion of the project. Areas that will be temporarily closed are also shown in red on the maps.

Construction for both locations is scheduled to begin in October 2015 and last until approximately the end of December. Some additional landscaping and planting work will occur in the spring of 2016 depending on weather conditions and suitable timing for live planting.

All dates are based on our current schedule and may be subject to change.

#### **Traffic Accommodation**

The sidewalks and roads within the fencing for the work area will be closed to all traffic and pedestrians for the duration of construction with detours available. Signs will be posted to advise residents of sidewalk and road closures and detours. Access to all residences will be maintained.

A detour will be set up for ETS bus routes and DATS along 96 Street and



temporary bus stops will be provided nearby.

# Safety

The construction areas will be fenced off. The public is asked to stay outside of fenced working areas as there will be open excavations and heavy machinery.
